

One in every three women experience sexual violence during their lifetime.

70 women die by suicide each day in the aftermath of sexual violence.

Something has to change

At the **Schools Consent Project**, we believe that education is prevention. Founded and run by criminal attorneys, we send lawyers into schools to teach young people about consent. We aim to normalize conversations about consent in order to reduce sexually harmful behaviour and create a safer society from the grassroots up.

Originally a UK charity, we have educated over 40,000 young people in the past 8 years and have recently begun providing consent workshops to football clubs and the UK Armed Forces.

In Spring 2023, we opened our first overseas arm in New York as the charity partner of the Tony-winning Broadway play, **Prima Facie**. Since then, we have:

- Hired our New York Manager, Kaitlin Andrews
- Trained attorneys from 17 firms and corporates
- Delivered workshops at schools including Beacon High School, Basis Independent School and Charter High School for Law and Social Justice



- Booked over 100 workshops at schools across all 5 boroughs...
- ...which educates approximately 3,500 young people about consent
